All Referrals for women birthing at NHW to be sent between 8-12 weeks

Please state preference to MGP on referral

Referral must contain detailed information on:

- Obstetric History
- Medical History
- Medications
- BMI
- Antenatal Investigations to be included with referral include:
 Blood Tests such as Blood Group & Antibodies, Hep B & C, HIV, FBE, Ferritin, Syphilis,
 Rubella and a MSU
- Dating Scan +/- 12/40 Ultrasound must be attached to referral as copies
- Genetic Screening MSS or NIPT testing to be attached to referral as copies or indicated that referral has been made/discussed

Note: Incomplete referrals WILL NOT be accepted for processing and will be returned to the referral source.

All referrals will be triaged according to the ACM Referral and Consultation Guidelines and NHW Criteria by a Registrar & Midwife. All referrals will be triaged according to Traffic Lights set by the ACM Referral and Consultation Guidelines & Northeast Health Wangaratta into Green (Low Risk), Amber (Medium Risk) and Red (High Risk) pregnancies. Medium Risk that have preference to MGP and High Risk referrals will be discussed at Audit by the Obstetric and Midwifery Team - Held 3 Tuesdays a month. If complications arise or complexity is too high – tertiary referrals may be made.

Triage Categories / Appointment Wait Times

Emergency Antenatal Care / After Hours:

Present to the NHW Accident & Emergency (A&E) Department. Then either sent to Midwifery for ongoing treatment, or stay in Accident & Emergency if non-pregnancy related.

Receipt of referral

0 – 3 days

Once the referral is complete, you will receive notification that the referral form has been received.

Referral Triage / Appointment 0 – 14 days

Once the completed referral has been triaged and processed you and the patient will receive notification with appointment details.

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
