### Your Rights and Responsibilities

#### You have the right to:

- Be treated with respect and dignity.
- Have access to information about the range of services available.
- Be included in decisions and make choices about your health care.
- Refuse to continue with services.
- Complain about services without fear.
- Have someone of your choice advocate for you.
- Have your personal information kept private and confidential.

## You are responsible for:

- The decisions you make.
- Keeping Northeast Health
   Wangaratta up to date with relevant
   information about your condition and
   circumstances.

# Support for patients with disability

Our Disability Liaison Officer provides support for people with disability, their families and carers to access services at Northeast Health Wangaratta.

- We do not take the place of health care professionals.
- We listen to what you need to access health care.
- We work with your health care team to ensure access the care and support that you need.

#### Before you come to hospital we can:

- provide information about support for patients, carers and families
- discuss what you need to access services and feel safe
- work with your health team to ensure you are provided with accessible and inclusive care
- provide support to attend appointments.

#### During your hospital stay we can:

- support you and your carer/s
- support and educate staff involved in your care
- help with information and planning to go home.

#### When you leave hospital we can:

- support access to health services and other health and human services.
- offer advice to health services about providing care that is accessible and inclusive for you.

#### **COVID-19 support we provide:**

- information and support to access COVID-19 screening
- information and support to access COVID-19 vaccination
- assistance with vaccination bookings for Supported Disability Accommodation services
- access to RATs (Rapid Antigen Tests).

# **Employment support for people with disability**

Our Disability Support Officer provides support and advocacy for staff and students at Northeast Health Wangaratta.

- We can partner with Disability Employment providers.
- We can provide tours of the work place (pending COVID restrictions).
- We are a source of information about vacancies and recruitment.

# We can support you to apply for work at NHW by:

- · assisting with your application
- discussing access needs before your interview
- providing support during your interview
- debriefing with you after your interview
- providing feedback after your interview.

#### On the job support we can provide:

- assistance with paperwork
- support through orientation and ongoing mandatory training
- · introductions to staff
- development of customised roster
- · advocacy during meetings
- applications for workplace modifications to meet your needs
- invitation to attend regular meetings with other staff living with disability.
