Who can access our services?

- All children from 0-17 years
- Young adults aged 18 years and enrolled in full-time education
- Adults who hold a valid pensioner concession or health care card

Some adults will receive priority care if indicated by risk factors. Our administration staff can assist with this information if applicable.

What costs are involved?

Public dental services are subsidised by the government. Fees paid by patients vary depending on eligibility status and services provided.



What type of dental care is offered?

Emergency Care

If you have a dental emergency, please contact us as soon as possible so that we can assess your condition and offer appropriate and timely care.

General Care - Child

Children are offered the next available appointment for general care.

General Care - Adult

For general care, adults will likely be put on a wait list. Please contact us if you change your address or phone number so that we can update your details. You will be contacted when you reach the top of the list.

Denture Assessment

If you require dentures, you will be placed on the denture wait list.

If you have existing dentures and/or any natural teeth you will need to have general care completed before receiving dentures.

Specialist Referral

Eligible patients may be referred to the Royal Dental Hospital of Melbourne for specialist dental care. A dental practitioner must first assess the problem.

Please note: waiting times and additional costs are involved.

Who provides dental care?

Dentists - provide general dental treatment for patients of all ages.

Dental and Oral Health Therapists - provide a range of dental treatment for children, and limited treatment for adults.

Dental Assistants - assist dental practitioners with the provision of dental care.

Dental Technicians - construct removable appliances

Oral Health Educators - provide dietary and educational advice and can assist you to stop smoking.

Dental Prosthetists - design, construct and fit removable dentures.
