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- Patients who are Pregnant (regardless of reason for referral)
- High Risk Foot Clinic (seen by dietitian in HRFC)
- Gestational Diabetes; diabetes in pregnancy (T1DM or T2DM)
- Malnutrition / suspected malnutrition / unintentional weight loss
- Clients with kidney disease
- Dialysis Clients (on non-admitted days)
- Coeliacs disease
- Chrons disease or inflammatory bowel disease
- Liver disease
- Oncology clients (on non-admitted days)
- Clients who are tube-fed (HEN clients)
- Children with failure to thrive / faltering growth
- Food allergy, including breastfed infants with suspected allergy
- Breastfeeding
- Fussy eating

Priority 2: within 4 weeks

- Diverticular disease
- Anaemia / iron deficiency

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
